Purpose of the Assignment

The aim of this assignment is to assess your understanding of the legal, professional and ethical responsibilities of health and social care workers. You will demonstrate how these responsibilities apply in real-world care settings and reflect on your ability to work in line with agreed ways of working.

Task 1: Report

Answer the following questions in detail using references to legislation, codes of practice, and regulatory standards. Ensure you address each of the assessment criteria:

Task 2: Application of Knowledge (Choose ONE Option)

You must choose either Option A (if employed or volunteering in a care setting) or Option B (if not currently working in care).

Option A: Work-Based Reflection

Write a reflective account based on your current or recent work in a health or social care setting. Address the following:

- 1. Describe a situation where you worked with others to support an individual and maintained professional relationships
- 2. Explain how you followed your organisation's agreed ways of working
- 3. Reflect on how you ensured partnership working, confidentiality, and communication
- 4. Identify any conflicts and how you managed them
- 5. Evaluate how this situation has improved your own professional practice

This option ensures the learner addresses:

- LO3 & AC 3.1-3.3 through describing partnership working, maintaining professional relationships, and resolving conflicts.
- LO2 & AC 2.1-2.3 via explaining adherence to agreed ways of working, organisational procedures, and confidentiality.
- LO1 & AC 1.1-1.2 through demonstrating awareness of working relationships in context.

The reflective approach also meets ACs requiring evaluation of professional practice improvement

Option B: Case Scenario Response

Scenario:

Layla is a care assistant supporting Ravi, an older adult with mobility issues and mild dementia. She must work with a physiotherapist, Ravi's daughter, and her senior care manager to ensure Ravi can stay at home safely. She notices that Ravi is more withdrawn than usual, and the physiotherapist disagrees with Layla's observations.

Answer the following:

- 1. What are Layla's responsibilities in this situation?
- 2. How should she manage the working relationship with the physiotherapist?
- 3. What are the agreed ways of working that apply here?
- 4. How can Layla involve others while maintaining Ravi's rights and dignity?
- 5. What actions should she take to report and resolve the situation?

This option is structured so each question aligns to the ACs:

- Responsibilities \rightarrow AC 1.1-1.2 and 2.1-2.3.
- Managing relationships → AC 3.1 & 3.2.
- Agreed ways of working → AC 2.2 & 2.3.
- Maintaining rights/dignity & involving others \rightarrow AC 3.2 and 3.3.
- Reporting & resolving situations → AC 3.3 and reflective skills linked to professional development
