THE AIM OF THIS ASSESSMENT

The aim of this assessment is to explore the concepts of teamwork while reflecting on your experiences of teamwork when undertaking the previous community project.

INSTRUCTIONS

Topic:

You are required to write an **essay** that covers the following three points:

1. Discuss your team's engagement and behaviours when undertaking assessment one in relation to the concepts of teamwork. For example, how the team worked together or not, roles people played within the team, and challenges faced.
You might like to refer to your formative plan to help you discuss what was planned in comparison to what happened.
2. Choose **one** aspect (component) of teamwork that you discovered from your discussion above and your reading of the academic literature. Explain this aspect (component) in greater detail to illustrate your understanding of working in a team.
3. Identify one specific challenge that **you** had working in your team and how this may impact you when working in a team in the future. Give two examples of how **you** can overcome this challenge.

4. Submission: Upload your finished essay into the Moodle drop box under the assessment tab before or on the due date.
- Word limit: 1200 words not including reference page
 - You need to use a minimum of five (5) academic literature sources to support your discussion and analysis. Some resources for this assignment will be supplied on Moodle.
 - While you still need to ensure you are using professional language because this essay requires some reflection personal pronouns can be used (e.g, I, my, our).
 - Maintain confidentiality by not using team member's names within your essay. Use pseudonyms or numbers (e.g. team member one, team member two), when discussing what happened.
 - Use APA 7th edition referencing. Information about this can be found on the library website.
